About Vyasa Mandira

This school was started in 1982 in a village called Ambalavayal in Wayanad, Kerala; which is currently running with limited financial support. It is a local English medium school where nearly 200+ students are studying till class 7 catering to the needy group of society. This is an unaided school. The lack of financial support and resources were quite visible once we visit the school.

The school lacked the basic amenities of water, proper roofing, flooring, doors /window to the class room or proper seating arrangement. The walls were not painted, the flooring were bad and even they are not able to complete the water tank project for the Kids.

Hari Sankar M, our SreshtaBharath member was in touch with E. Sasidharan, the PTA member of the school, who explained the situation in more details about the school where there is no plastering and even for few classes there were no flooring. We received a request letter from the head teacher and the committee for this issue. 
Sree Vyasa vidya mandiram, a Bharatheeya Vidya Nikethan institution which comes under the Educational wing of RSS is working at Ambalavayal since 1982. The institution is being run by a local committee. Three years back the committee has erected a new two storied building demolishing the existing delapidated old one. The school from LKG (Arun) to 7th standard is being run in this rough, implasted and unattractive building. Due to the same reason the strength of the students is slow low and it is not more than 197. The governing body and the school development bodies including parents have done beyond their limits and further exploitation is unthinkable. The school building situates in a 25 cents compound and it has little updati facilities.

We expect a considerable growth in the strength of the students, if the major basic needs are fulfilled

➤ **Execution**

Our aim was to bring the school in a better atmosphere so that the local population can possess a quality oriented education with Sanathana Dharma background, and accessible to the needy and all grounds of the society. A detailed meeting was held with the school PTA team and they submitted their formal request of help to the Sreshtabharath team

Please find the below photos which were taken during the construction work: We took up this Project within 3 months of the first request sent to us and we aimed in completing the project during the summer vacation so that a small surprise and a little bundle of joy could be given to the kids and the Teachers there. Plastering, flooring and painting work was completed in 3 weeks' time. (was in May, 2017). We ensured that his work was completed with perfection and there was no compromise on the work quality.

It was a pleasant surprise for students, teachers, parents when the school was reopened in June, 2017 after summer Vacation. They were extremely happy by looking at the new school atmosphere.

We SreshtaBharath as a family learned a lot while driving this project. Our own capabilities were challenged many times, and also our weakness and limitations were identified. It gave us a wide angle on planning, strategic move to accomplish such medium sized project in our capacity of few SB members. We are planning to increase the scope for such projects and as well planning to include more members to support upcoming projects. . We were happy that for sure, students/teachers are benefited by our small initiative.
