1. Introduction

Lock down due to Covid 19 pandemic brought forth financial difficulties to common man, especially those living in the lower strata of the society. Worst hit were the daily wage earners who overnight had no source of income and found it difficult to even feed themselves and their families. Both Central and State governments did pitch in with financial and allied supports. Sreshtabharath members too believed this was a cause worth supporting and pledged to raise donations to support daily wage earners / labourers during Covid-19 lockdown in Bangalore.

A similar need was also identified to support daily wage earners in the rural areas of Wayanad district in Kerala.

2. Beneficiaries:

Daily wage earners, labourers around Sarjapura road, Yamare village & Hosahalli Village. As many of them belonged to states outside Karnataka, they did not possess ration cards, and hence were deprived of benefits to avail free rations.

3. Sreshtabharath decision

Sreshtabharath decided to give 70,000 Rs for the food distribution. 50k can be given to the Samanwaya team in Bangalore and 20k should be distributed to the Wayanad Sevabharathi program.

4. Mode of Support

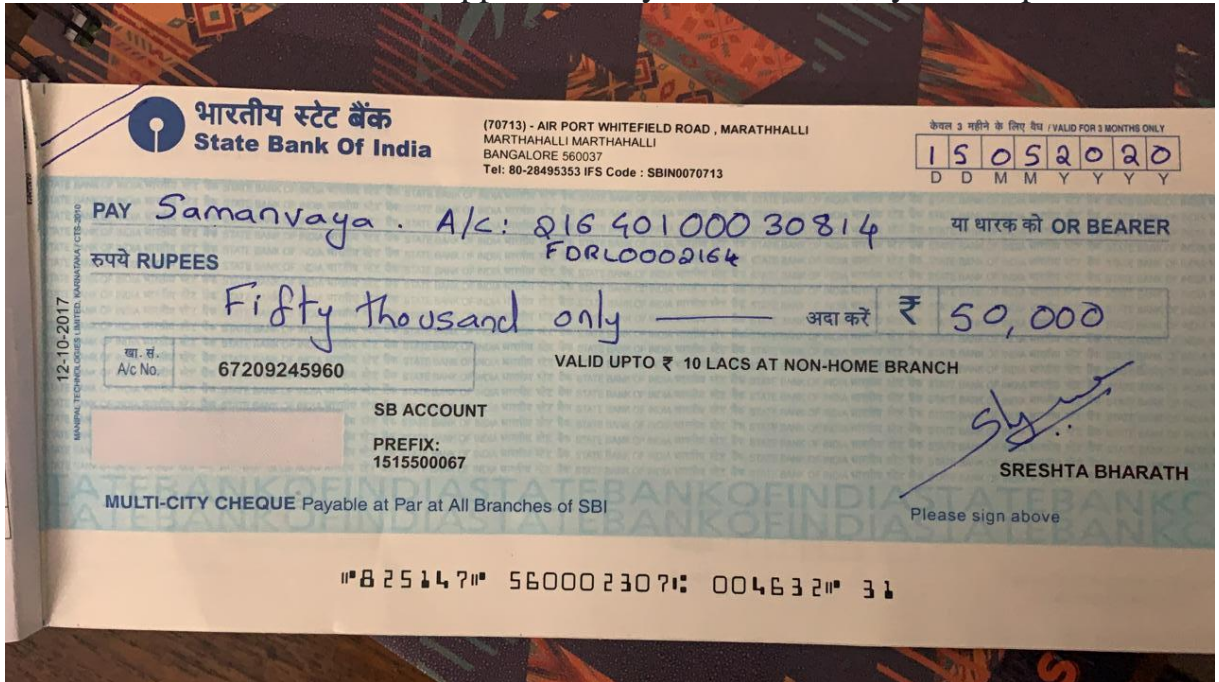
Sreshtabharath decided to partner with a Bangalore based NGO, Samanwaya, who were engaged in distribution of food kits, near Sarjapura in Bangalore. The food kits contained Rice -5 kgs, Atta - 2kgs, Dal - 500 mgs, oil - 500 ml, Salt 1 pack, onion -1 kg, potato- 1 kg).

The plan was to support a family with 1 food kit, which would help them for roughly 4 days.

We plan to make use of a van which has a police pass to carry out such activities and the vehicle is already identified.

5. Target distribution:

To distribute food kits worth approximately Rs 50,000/- , by 25th April.
